### Entry Requirements

A pass in SPM with a minimum of Grade C (GP 2.0) in any two (2) subjects or its equivalent;

A pass in STAM with a minimum grade of Jayyid;  
OR

A pass in UEC with minimum Grade B in five (5) subjects;  
OR

A pass in Matriculation / Foundation or its equivalent with a minimum CGPA of 2.0;  
OR

A Diploma in Early Childhood Education or its equivalent with a minimum CGPA of 2.0;  
OR

A Diploma in any field or its equivalent with a minimum CGPA of 2.0;  
OR

Pass Diploma Kemahiran Malaysia (DKM) / Diploma Lanjutan Kemahiran Malaysia (DLKM) / Diploma Vokasional Malaysia (DVM) with a minimum CGPA of 2.50 in relevant field subject to the approval of the Senate and MUST attend bridging courses;  
OR

Pass DKM / DLKM / DVM with at least CGPA 2.00 AND have at least two (2) years of work experience in the relevant field and MUST attend bridging courses;  
OR

Pass BTEC Level 4 and 5 and pass SPM with at least three (3) credits in any subjects;  
OR

Any other equivalent qualifications recognised by the Malaysian Government;  
OR

Entry requirements for admission into the Bachelor's programme (Level 6, MQF) through APEL A as approved by the Ministry of Education (MOHE). Applicants must be/have:

1. A Malaysian citizen; AND
2. The candidate should be more than 21 years of age in the year of application;
3. Relevant work experience / prior experiential learning; AND
