Academic Integrity Policy

UNITAR is unwavering in its commitment to academic integrity, expecting all students and staff to uphold the principles of honesty, ethical conduct, and full acknowledgement of authorship in all academic endeavours. Breaches of academic integrity are classified as academic misconduct, allowing nuanced and proportionate responses.

When a breach is suspected, the case shall be reported to the Academic Dishonesty Committee for investigation. All individuals involved are entitled to procedural fairness and unbiased adjudication throughout the process.

To address challenges related to Artificial Intelligence (AI), UNITAR adopts a dual-track system:

- secure tasks strictly prohibit unapproved AI usage;
- open tasks permit AI assistance only when explicitly allowed and properly disclosed.

Sanctions for academic misconduct range from remedial education for minor breaches, to formal penalties, and disciplinary action for serious violations. Confidentiality is maintained throughout the process, and appeal rights are upheld. All cases are centrally recorded, and the data is used to inform prevention measures and educational strategies, reinforcing a strong culture of academic integrity at UNITAR.
