UNITAR is committed to upholding human rights and ensuring that modern slavery—including forced labour, human trafficking, and exploitation—does not occur within our institution.

We promote a culture of ethical conduct and strictly prohibit all forms of modern slavery. Our commitments include:

- Ensuring transparency in our operations and supply chains.
- Promoting awareness and education on modern slavery among staff and students.
- Taking appropriate action against individuals or entities found to be involved in modern slavery practices.

Any suspected case of modern slavery must be reported immediately to the Head of the Student Experience Department. All reports will be treated with strict confidentiality and investigated thoroughly. Support services, including counselling, will be made available to affected individuals.
