

STUDENT WELLBEING AND SAFETY POLICY

This policy defines the principles guiding UNITAR in promoting and ensuring student wellbeing and safety on campus, online, or off-campus during any UNITAR-endorsed or arranged activities.

UNITAR is committed to fostering a healthy and safe environment for all students by:

- Provide safe spaces on campus where students can go if they feel that they need immediate support;
- Provide an accessible and confidential system for reporting well-being and safety concerns and incidents, ensuring timely and appropriate responses;
- perform regular safety audits of campus facilities to identify and address potential hazards.
- foster a culture of safety and wellbeing through community engagement initiatives

Students can raise their concerns by logging into the student portal to access the One Stop Centre and/or counselling services. All students will be treated with dignity and respect, and their concerns will be handled in a sensitive and confidential manner. The students' privacy will be protected to prevent any unwarranted breaches of confidentiality.
